### 'End the Cage Age' European Citizens' Initiative (ECI)





'End the Cage Age' European Citizens' Initiative invited the European Commission to propose legislation to prohibit the use of:

- cages for farmed rabbits, pullets, broiler breeders, layer breeders, quail, ducks and geese and enriched cages for laying hens
- farrowing crates for sows
- sow stalls
- enclosed calf pens














#### **EU Parliament Resolution – 10 June 2021**





#### **Unprecedented commitment – 30 June 2021**



The European **Commission** made a legally-binding commitment to adopt a legislative proposal on banning cages for all species named in the ECI



### 2021 – year of hope





#### In preparation for the proposal



The EU Commission was planning to reform its food policy, including to revise the animal welfare laws (Farm to Fork strategy in 2020)

- Proposals for animal welfare, including banning of cages, scheduled to be delivered by Q3 2023
- Proceeded with a number of actions to prepare for the legislation (REFIT process)
- Asked for scientific evidence from its food agency EFSA, which concluded **farmed** animals should be free from cages

### 2023 – sudden U-turn of EU agricultural strategy





- 2023: year of broken promises The End of the Cage Age ECI was derailed
- Most other new laws for farmed animals & the environment were not delivered or weakened, severely damaging the agricultural part of the EU's Green Deal ('Farm to Fork' Strategy)



#### The attack on science



 The industry lobbyists claimed the EU's scientific conclusions were not "impartial" and included "serious scientific errors"

 They took out their guns for hire — be it scientists or journalists, to manufacture propaganda & cloud the truth about animal farming



#### **Diversion tactics**

- Their fear-mongering tactics included spreading inflated economic analyses and alarmist fears of food security linked to the Ukraine war
- They managed to hijack the narrative & divert attention from the fact that it is speculation on the financial markets that drove the cost-of-living crisis



#### **Discrediting dissenting voices**



The factory farming industry tried to undermine the credibility of the campaigners and journalists, with the hope to silence its critics and scare away other potential "troublemaker S"



### MEP voting record for farmed animals, by EP group





#### Where are we now?



- ECIs: A decade of existence, over 100 registered, ten surpassed the threshold of 1 million signatures, five dedicated to animals
- End the Cage Age: the only ECI with a clear positive commitment by the Commission
- By not delivering on this commitment the Commission prioritizes big business interests over those of citizens and risks making the ECI instrument de facto void
- Treaty obligations ignored, future of the instrument is questioned
- The Commission's lack of action is contributing to a loss of trust in the EU Institutions






#### Threats to democracy

In your view, which of the following are the most serious threats to democracy in [COUNTRY]? (Up to three answers allowed, % EU27)


